District Summer Credit offerings are through a blended learning model of in-person and virtual curriculum offerings.

The in-person portion of the course will be determined after teachers are hired for these courses. They may or may not be at your home high school. Transportation is not provided for this program.

District Summer Credit programs will be offered in two sessions: June 12-June 30 and July 10-July 28.

Initial meeting date for June session will be May 31 at 6:00PM at Boone County HS

Initial meeting date for July session will be June 28 at 6:00PM at Boone County HS

Registration closes May 15th.

Each course costs \$150. All courses will count in the student's GPA.
