- Name:** Boone County Pee Football/Cheerleading Scholarship  
**Amount:** \$500.00  
**Who's Eligible:** The student must be a graduating senior that participated in BCPWFL through football or cheerleading from grades 1-8. The candidate must have continued to volunteer hours with the league.  
**Deadline:** The scholarship must be postmarked by September 15, 2014  
**Qualifications:** Complete the scholarship form and mail it in by the deadline.

Eligibility must be affirmed and signed by the high school guidance counselor and the school district's board chairperson and superintendent. Student must have at least a 20 ACT score.
