Program Overview

- ⇒ Positive Behavioral Interventions and Support (PBIS) helps to create safer and more effective schools
- ⇒ It is a school-wide and classroom positive behavior support system
- ⇒ Allows schools to design, implement and evaluate effective school-wide, classroom and non classroom and individual student behavioral expectations
- ⇒ Increases student learning and decreases classroom disruptions
- ⇒ Is a positive approach used when teaching academics and behavior



Expectations

We have adopted school wide expectations that are used to remind students of our behavior and academic goals:

- . BE Safe**
- . BE Respectful**
- . BE Responsible**



Students are taught classroom procedures as well as common area procedures for hallways, cafeteria, restrooms, etc. Visuals are posted throughout the school reminding students of the school wide expectations.

School Wide System of Consequences

PBIS is a positive approach to behavior and provides consequences for student behavior.

Positive behavior

- ⇒ **Students are rewarded with Tiger Tickets throughout the school day in the classroom, and common areas, including the bus.**
- ⇒ **Monthly celebrations are held for students whose tickets are drawn at random**

Negative behavior

- ⇒ **Minor incidents are handled by teacher**
- ⇒ **Major incidents are referred to the office**
