On October 9th, 2002 Congress passed legislation known as the No Child Left Behind Act. One requirement of schools is the release of student information to military recruiters. Parents may elect to opt out of this release of their child's information if a request is made in writing.

If you wish for your son/daughter NOT to be on the recruitment list for the armed forces of the United States of America, please return this notice with the student's name, grade and a parent signature. The list is released to recruiters: therefore, we will need to have signatures on file by October 12th, 2017. This is to give reasonable assurance that your child's name will be omitted.
