

Dual Enrollment Requirements

Applications due on March 1, 2017

- Students must enter the Dual Enrollment course number in IC Student Portal requests. Choose course number that corresponds to the college attending.
 - Students must enter alternate electives in case the Dual Enrollment is not approved.
 - Students must attach Intent Form to application noting when they wish to attend dual enrollment.
 - Please follow the requirements per College that you want to attend.

NKU – School Based Scholars Program

- Students must have a 20 on the ACT and a 3.25 to be eligible.
- Students must apply online at <http://appliesbs.nku.edu> by March 1, 2017
- Students must turn in Disclosure Form to guidance office March 1, 2017– <http://nkusbs.nku.edu> (Click on Admission Requirements.)
- \$40 Fee (This can be paid online too)
- Transcripts/Test Scores – will be sent by guidance office.

Thomas More – Gemini Program

- Students must have an overall GPA of 3.5 or better in the above units.
- Complete paper application and turn into guidance office March 1, 2017.
- Transcript/Test scores – will be sent by guidance office.

Gateway – Regional Academy

- 16 or older.
- Students must have 2.0 GPA
- Students must meet benchmark on ACT in the area of course they want to take.
- Student must apply online at <http://gateway.kctcs.edu> - click on the “Apply Now” button by March 1, 2017.
- Students must turn in Disclosure Form to guidance office March 1, 2017– forms available in guidance
- Transcript/Test scores – will be sent by guidance office.

Early College Program – Boone County Schools

- Students must have GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Students must meet benchmark on ACT to be eligible.
- Students must apply at each university - NKU, Thomas More, and Gateway and follow application guidelines for each school.
- Transcript/Test scores - will be sent by guidance office.
