Improvement Plan**

- Noted that funding for high-achievers/Pre-AP goals would also include funds for ELA Springboard materials – plan revised to \$15,000; Explained that the funding sources are determined based on our Average Daily Attendance
- Explained that sanctions can be applied to low achieving schools which would include more assistance, etc.
- Items of concern were addressed and revised to include teacher involvement.
