Dear ATC and Homebuilders Applicant:

Students in their Junior and Senior year of High School are eligible to take courses at the Boone County Area Technical Center or Homebuilders Program. Students who attend either program take 3 courses at Ryle and 3 courses at the ATC or Homebuilders. Programs include:

- Health Sciences
- Electricity
- Welding
- Diesel Mechanics
- Metal Fabrication
- Automobile Technology
- Applied Machining
- Homebuilders-not at ATC but through the Homebuilders Association

Students are expected to maintain good grades, attendance, and behavior at the ATC or Homebuilders and at Ryle High School in order to stay in the program. Students also **MUST** have room in their schedules for Junior and senior year. **IT IS A PRIVILEGE TO ATTEND EITHER PROGRAM; MORE STUDENTS APPLY THAN ARE ALLOWED TO ATTEND.** The selection committee will look at grades, discipline, and attendance when determining selections. Interviews may also be required. Students who are not successful nor have been successful at Ryle High School **will not be given the privilege of attending either program.** If students are not being successful at Ryle or in the program during the year, the administration reserves the right to remove a student from participation in the programs and to reschedule students in classes at Ryle High School. As well, students must pass classes at the ATC or Homebuilders in order to remain in the program. Students must be listed in Infinite Campus as a Junior or Senior to be allowed to attend the ATC. Homebuilders is open to 10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>. Seniors are not permitted to apply for the ATC unless they attended as a junior.

Gateway Community and Technical College offers college credits for students who complete coursework at the BCATC. Students who earn a C average (B average in Diesel) in coursework will have grades submitted to Gateway CTC at the end of the course for awarding of college credits. **NOTE: EVEN THOUGH YOU MAY NOT ATTEND GATEWAY, YOUR CREDITS CAN TRANSFER TO THE COLLEGE/SCHOOL OF YOUR CHOICE.**

This is a rigorous program that requires that students have the ability to read, think analytically, and solve problems. Math and reading skills are a must for success in this program. Students who feel as though math and reading are not important will not be as successful in the program. As well, the BCATC is looking for students who work hard, who are on time, and who are hard working within the program.
