

Procedural guidelines for Dual Enrollment classes:

- When taking classes at NKU, GATEWAY and Thomas More campuses, students will work with the particular university/college to register for courses. Students must have a minimum of 6 courses total between the universities and Ryle. **However, a student is required take at least one class each semester.**
- Classes taken through dual enrollment will be calculated as part of the RHS GPA at a 1.04 index on a 5.0 scale and will appear on your high school transcript. All course will be indicated on both high school and college transcripts.
- Student schedules will be updated to show dual enrollment course once proof of enrollment is given to the guidance office. Students are **REQUIRED** to supply a schedule for both fall and spring semesters.
- On days that students do not have college courses, they will not report to school until their scheduled classes at Ryle.
- Students are required to both check in and check out in the attendance office as they arrive and depart school if it falls outside of the start and ending of the school day.
- In the event of a Boone County delay or snow day, students will be required to attend their college classes unless the university/college determines the need to close.

Costs

- NO application fee for dual enrollment (if you plan to attend any of the universities/college as a college freshman, you will need to pay the application fee).
- Cost is approximately \$56 per credit hour (most courses are 3 credit hours), this is a huge savings.
- Tuition can be paid on the universities/college website or by stopping in to the financial office:
- Students will be responsible to buy the required books for these courses. The cost of books vary with the average price being approximately \$100.00.
- NKU requires payment one week before school starts and GCTC and Thomas More requires payment upon receipt of bill. If a student meets eligibility for the Dual Enrollment Scholarship, the university will reimburse the student upon receipt of the scholarship money.
- If applicable, students are responsible for purchasing the appropriate parking pass.

Special Notes

- **If you are choosing to take NKU, Thomas More or Gateway courses to meet your US History Requirement you must take BOTH of the following:**
HIS 102 and HIS 103-NKU
HIS 114 and HIS 115- Thomas More
HIS 108 and HIS 109- GCTC
- You are beginning your college transcript and GPA-please choose wisely and find balance to make sure you can manage the coursework you have chosen.
- Be advised it is ALWAYS at the discretion of the college or university you attend after high school to accept transfer credits.
- Always check prerequisites of courses offered at the university/college, this may be in the form of course work or a minimum of ACT in a subject area.
- **YOU MUST Advise YOUR GUIDANCE COUNSELOR PRIOR TO DROPPING A COURSE.**
- If applicable, you need to send a copy of any AP test score reports you have to NKU/TMC/ GCTC.
- If you have taken dual-credit with other universities, you will also need to send your official transcript to NKU/ TMC/GCTC.
- If you are accepted into the program, you agree to sign up for Remind to receive pertinent information that you may miss by being absent from Ryle, as well as agreeing to check your informational RAP folder (located in the Guidance office) weekly.

Gateway Community and Technical College allows high school students to take an UNLIMITED NUMBER college classes at a reduced rate. In addition, two classes may be FREE thru a KHEAA scholarship (please note students must apply for this scholarship. Information will be provided to these students at the start of the school year). Requirements

- Student must have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher.
- Student must meet benchmark in all areas of the ACT:
English: 18; Math: 19; Reading: 20
- Provide own transportation to the university.

Thomas More University

The Gemini Program offered thru Thomas More College. It allows high school students to take an UNLIMITED NUMBER college classes at a reduced rate. In addition, two classes may be FREE thru a KHEAA scholarship (please note students must apply for this scholarship). In order to be considered for this program students must meet the following requirements (NO EXCEPTIONS):

Requirements

- Student must have a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher.
- Student must meet benchmark in all areas of the ACT:
English: 18; Math: 19; Reading: 20
- Provide own transportation to the university.

EARLY COLLEGE GATEWAY COMMUNITY AND TECHNICAL COLLEGE

Through a partnership with NKU, Thomas More, and Gateway Community and Technical College (GCTC) students attend college for half a day at the GCTC Florence/Union campus. These courses are provided at a dramatically reduced rate of \$56 per credit hour (\$168 per three-hour course), saving a student thousands in future college expenses.

The program provides students with college-level experiences in high school, so they are better prepared for post-secondary success after graduation. Classes count towards general education requirements. Transportation to and from GCTC will be provided.

Requirements

- Student must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Student must meet benchmark in all areas of the ACT:
English: 18; Math: 22; Reading: 20

INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY:

The School Based Scholars Program is offered thru NKU. It allows high school students to take an UNLIMITED NUMBER college classes at a reduced rate. In addition, two classes may be FREE thru a KHEAA scholarship (please note students must apply for this scholarship). A wealth of information and important details are included at <http://NKUSBS.nku.edu>. In order to be considered for this program students must meet the following requirements (NO EXCEPTIONS):

Requirements

- Student must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Student must have a composite ACT score of 20 or higher and meet benchmarks in all areas:
English: 18; Math: 19; Reading: 20
- Students must maintain a C or better in each college course for continued eligibility.
- Provide own transportation to the university.

To Apply

- 1) Complete LRHS application, completed and **signed by both student and parent**.
- 2) Complete NKU Early Admission application completed online:

- 3) Sign the **NKU Disclosure form** and attach to your LRHS application.
- 4). Transcripts will be sent by the guidance office.
- 5) Tuition is due the week before classes begin. **NKU DOES NOT SEND BILLS**. Please mark your calendars. Late fees apply if tuition is not paid by the due date. If student applies for the KHEAA scholarship, NKU will reimburse you once those funds are released.
