

# Incoming 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Scheduling Directions and Timeline 2020-2021 School Year

## **IMPORTANT DATES:**

### **February 4, 2020:**

- \*\*Students receive 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Scheduling Materials at the Incoming 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Scheduling Information Night at Ryle High School (Large Gym: 6:30pm-8:30pm).
- \*\*Students who do not attend will receive the paperwork from their middle schools later that week.

### **February 14, 2020:**

- \*\***Deadline** for students to enter course requests into Infinite Campus (Middle School teachers will be assisting the students with this process)
- \*\*Core Content Teachers will be entering the requests for core courses
- \*\*Students will enter elective course requests

### **February 17, 2020: ADVISORY DAY-RYLE HIGH SCHOOL**

- \*\*Students and parents should plan to meet with a Ryle staff member to review course requests that are entered into Infinite Campus for the students' 9<sup>th</sup> Grade year. .
- \*\*These meetings will be held at Ryle HS 8am-11am and 12:30pm-2:30pm-no appointment necessary-MEDIA CENTER

## **Additional Information:**

- Students should review the course description guide to learn about requirements and course offerings available. The course book can also be found on the Ryle website under Raider Basics-->Student Scheduling Information or Under Quick Links
- Use the Scheduling Worksheet to plan out your courses for 9<sup>th</sup> grade year
- Most students take PE/Health during their freshman year, but students can take this during the summer or another year of high school if it works better for their 4 year plan.
- All Core Content Courses, including Honors and AP courses, WILL BE ASSIGNED BY AN 8<sup>th</sup> GRADE TEACHER
- Incoming 9<sup>th</sup> Graders will pick their electives and enter them into Infinite Campus with help from their 8<sup>th</sup> grade teachers
- Students who wish to take a course that a teacher does not feel comfortable recommending, can fill out a Challenge Form (hot pink). The middle school counselors have copies of these forms or they can be found on the Ryle website under Raider Basics. The challenge forms must be completely filled out and turned in on February 17<sup>th</sup> to Ryle High School.
- **On February 17, 2020**, Ryle High School will host Advisory Day- At this time, parents and students will meet with a teacher at Ryle to confirm the schedule requests their child has made and answer any questions.
- Students interested in taking Visual Arts I must complete the online survey that can be found under Raider Basics. If this is not filled out, students will be removed from the course.
