| Reports | <p>a. Activity Funds - Report was reviewed and approved by concensus.</p> <p>b. SBDM Funds - Report was reviewed and approved by concensus.</p> <p>c. Summit Update/Expansion - Mr. Poiry reviewed and explained the proposed staffing plan for the upcoming 2017-2018 school year; includes the addition of another Blended Learning team at each grade level including 6th; some movement of staff was necessary; plan is to roll-out to parents as it was done last year (emails, webpage announcements, meetings, phone calls, etc.)</p> <p>d. Rosetta Update - We will be hiring a Spanish Teacher for next year; will serve as a support to those teachers managing Rosetta Stone as well as teach regular classes during 6th/7th Arts/Humanities time; 8th grade may offer Spanish I for credit (year long course);</p> |
| Old Business | <p>a. Policy Review (2nd Reading) - Assessment of Individual Student Progress including Testing and Reporting - Reviewed and approved as printed.</p> <p>b. Policy Review (2nd Reading) - School Improvement Plan - Revised statement regarding timeline to read “within 30 days of public release of state assessment data” - Approved as revised.</p> |
| New Business | <p>a. Growth Data Review - Mr. Poiry reviewed Fall to Winter growth data regarding interventions and the effectiveness; data will be shared with ELA, Math, and SpEd next week; full staff will review in the future; plan is to implement Reading Assistant in ALL</p> |

Reading BOLD classes; re-inviting students to ESS Novice REducation (after school Tuesday); plan to request additional funds to continue TenMarks to 2017-2018 school year; hope to revise tiered reading interventions to provide more differentiated interventions and a clearer path for progression; build a data dashboard to sync with all data sources to track student progress and growth; clarify that BOLD remediation classes are not for PBL; may move SpEd students back to regular BOLD classes

c. Professional Development Calendar Exchange Dates - Proposed Calendar Exchange Dates were reviewed with council and approved by consensus for presentation to the faculty

d. New World Language Position/Technology/Chrome Books - Responsibility for replacement of Chromebooks falls to the school; need to replace 1 grade level per year; textbook money MAY be used; priority to keep KETS money to be used for hardware, software, repair, and instruction; World Language Teacher was given based on the premise that Council would make best effort to contribute financially; Mr. Poiry will investigate options and revisit at a future council meeting.
