Summit Update - New training has been completed; teacher teams/grade levels/content areas are meeting to debrief; meeting for Summit parents ONLY will be scheduled during the first week in August for a general overview; more detailed information will be provided during curriculum night after school starts</p> <p>d. Rosetta Stone Update - All students will have access but may not have a formal time scheduled during the day (in cases of remediation, jazz band, etc.) New world language teacher will provide additional support in the area of culture to those BOLD classes working on Rosetta Stone.</p>
Old Business	<p>a. Camp Hawk - Friday, August 28th, 8:30-2:30; currently 42 registered; more will come for walk-in registration; 15 teachers have volunteered to assist</p>
New Business	<p>a. Summer School - student progress reports - Average attendance 45 students; 80% students showed growth according to STAR in Math and Reading; transportation was HUGELY successful (2 buses provided); PTA was a big help with incentives which contributed to greater motivation and attendance; programs included TenMarks, Reading Assistant and literature circles; 8th graders completed summer reading assignments for high school; possible considerations for changes next year - longer day/fewer weeks, invite incoming sixth graders to our program</p>

b. Policy Review (1st Reading) - Extracurricular Policy - Questions were made regarding how students on the blended learning teams will be affected. Ms. Payne explained that the computer grade is just a first check; teachers are contacted as a follow-up. Council agreed to add "Parent contact will be documented" to each of the three consequences. A second reading will be conducted at the next meeting.
