

Planning and Resolution of Issues Regarding Instructional Practices

KRS160.345(2)(i)6

Instructional Practice – Instructional Practices are techniques, specific, and general, used by teachers to teach awareness, knowledge and skills, monitor students while they learn and assess, and report their progress. Instruction is how the students are taught.

Committee – The curriculum committee will be responsible for:

1. Staying abreast of current state-of-the-art instructional practices.
2. Assessment the needs of teachers utilizing surveys, observations, etc.
3. Identifying priorities for implementing instructional practices.
4. Reporting to the school council as needed.

Sharing – The committee shall share information it obtains with the total faculty by such means as printed materials, faculty meetings, mini workshops, and media.
