

Selection and Implementation of Discipline and Classroom Management Techniques

KRS160.345(2)(i)7

Discipline (defined) – Discipline shall be defined as a system for managing student behavior for promoting an environment that is free from fear, disorder, and for establishing responsibilities for students, parents, and school personnel regarding student behavior.

Standing Committee – A standing committee shall be formed to assist the management of this function. The committee shall make recommendations and report to the council. The committee shall be chaired by the assistant principal. The committee shall be responsible for:

1. Assessing present policies and procedures.
2. Evaluating current discipline and student behavior management strategies to handle inappropriate student behaviors.
3. Developing a set of school rules.
4. Researching alternative discipline techniques.
5. Updating current procedures.
6. Implementing and communicating any new discipline policies and student behavior management procedures.

Present Policy – The present policies and procedures for discipline and classroom management techniques shall continue to be the policy and procedure unless and until changed by the school council.

Reporting – The discipline committee shall gather data on discipline concerns annually and report the results to the council with recommendations for improvements in discipline procedures and classroom management strategies.
