<b>Reports</b>	<p>a. <b>Activity Budget</b> – Council reviewed and approved by consensus.</p> <p>b. <b>SBDM Budget</b> – Council reviewed and approved by consensus.</p>
<b>Old Business</b>	<p>Mr. Poiry asked the council members if there were any questions or need for clarification regarding either the Rosetta Stone Program or the Summit Blended Learning Programs that were presented last month. None were voiced. Mr. Poiry said that students/parents are already indicating interest in both programs.</p>

**New Business**

**a. Program Review – Writing (Mrs. Lindsey Wilder)** – Mrs. Wilder explained that an increased emphasis on Project Based Learning and Service Learning has resulted in a wider scope of writing in all subject areas. This has allowed us to score Distinguished in some areas that were previously Proficient. Area for growth includes more communication with the community regarding our writing programs.

**b. Program Review – PLCS (Ms. Carrie Judd)** – Ms. Judd indicated that there were minimal changes to the actual scoring of the Program Review. Even with new faculty in some positions, most areas remain unchanged. Some additional evidence was available including Career Day, Operation Preparation, etc.

**c. Program Review – AH (Ms. Amy Grant)** – Ms. Grant shared that the AH Program Review will maintain its Proficient Status. Numerous additional types of evidence were available and areas for growth have been identified.

**d. Program Review – World Language (Mr. Poiry)** – The World Language review will be scored as Needs Improvement. Based on the three-year plan presented at the last meeting, improvement is expected. Mr. Poiry also pointed out that it is unlikely to reach Proficient without a dedicated World Language teacher, but that we currently lack that allocation.
