- a. **Report from Council of Councils (JCourtney)** – Highlights included information about the Career and College Readiness Program rolling out; MakerSpace Technology being available to all Boone County schools and students; Early College Program and other acceleration opportunities.
- b. **Writing Program Review (LWilder)**– Proficient this year – Areas for Growth: more collaboration across content areas; actively participating (professional development and training); collaboration in the community
- c. **Art Program Review (KBacelieri)** – Proficient this year – BOLD has made a big difference in achieving this level; no “needs improvement” areas; needs a committee; looking for more emphasis on art
- d. **Practical Living/Consumer Skills Program Review (CJudd)**– Solid proficient in all areas – evidence is everywhere; distinguished in some areas
- e. **World Language Program Review (MPoiry)**– Needs Improvement – Introduction to Spanish (9 wk rotation with Mrs. St. B during Bold); Services provided to and through ELL students; 6th grade Geography and 7th grade World History support some parts of the PR but there is not enough exploration in other content areas; goal is global competency in all classes; incorporated into all classes.
