 - i. Eighth grade U. S. History teacher, Doug Logan, has been nominated by the Sons of the Revolution for the History Teacher of the Year recognition.
 - ii. The students on the Superintendents Advisory Council are continuing to work on their district wide initiatives.
 - iii. NJHS Induction was held recently. Mr. Poiry recognized sponsor, Mrs. Saint Blanchard for a job well done.
 - iv. Mr. Poiry shared that OMS eighth graders scored the highest in the district on the recent Explore Test.
 - ✓ Two schools, OMS and CMS, had positive growth in the composite.
 - ✓ All schools met the Benchmark for English.
 - ✓ OMS met the Benchmark for Reading (.6 Gain)
 - ✓ OMS and GMS met the benchmark in Math.
 - ✓ OMS met the Benchmark for Science (.9 Gain)
 - ✓ CMS and OMS had positive growth in all four subjects.
 - ✓ OMS had statistically significant growth in ALL areas.
 - ✓ OMS had the greatest growth in English .8, Math .5, Reading .6, Science .9, and Composite .7
 - ✓ CMS, OMS, GMS, and CEMS have a mean above the national average in all areas.
 - ✓ OMS is the highest performing with a 17.2
