	<p><b>d. Public Comment</b> – Mrs. Payne asked for public comment. There was no public comment.</p>
	<p><b>a. SBDM (Munis) Report</b> – Approved by consensus <b>b. School Activity</b> – Approved by consensus <b>c. Summit Update</b> –83% current in focus areas, 88% have no overdue projects, 82% have cognitive skills above 85, 98% scored above 70% on math.</p>
<b>New Business</b>	<p><b>a. Teacher Impact Survey</b> – Ms. Payne informed the council that the teachers would be taking a state survey that asked questions about school culture, parent involvement, teacher’s role in school, etc. This survey must be administer/facilitated by a SBDM teacher. Mrs. Magee had volunteered but Mrs. Payne said it would have to be a vote by SBDM if either of the other SBDM teachers wanted the opportunity. Mr. Clausen denied. Mrs. Silbernagel was not present. The SBDM approved by consensus that Mrs. Magee would be the survey facilitator. Mrs. Magee will have the codes in teachers’ mailbox and email with directions will be sent by Friday.</p> <p><b>b. Course Code</b> – Ms. Payne explained to the council that a teacher had summited a grievance to the district concerning more than 3 preps for the UA teachers. Ms. Payne stated that the conclusion drawn by the district supported the teacher’s position and OMS must become compliant with the contract by 4<sup>th</sup> quarter. Ms. Payne requested that the council approve either a course code change or a name change for the UA courses making those courses comprehensive. Meaning the courses teach a common curriculum for 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> differentiated by students’ abilities. Ms. Payne explained that when checking with the district she found that there are state course codes that include 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup>. She also mentioned that this would allow for a more personalized learning because OMS UA courses are not “pathway” courses. Meaning currently there is no requirement that a student have a UA class in the previous grade to have</p>

	<p>it in the next grade level. She gave several examples proving that a UA pathway is not the current practice. (students who take semester long classes; physical or mental limitations/permissions to not participate, religious reasons, etc) SBDM approved the course code change or name change whichever would apply for each course by consensus. (each council member was called by name to record their vote) Ms. Payne said she would follow up with the school counselor to make the changes before 4<sup>th</sup> quarter.</p> <p><b>c. Review of Technology Policy (1<sup>st</sup> read)</b> – Ms. Magee as that ear pods be added as a banned item. Mrs. Maddox as it smart watches could also be added. Ms. Payne said she would up the Technology policy to be review again by the council.</p> <p><b>d. Waived PD days – Approved permission for faculty to vote. By consensus.</b></p>
