

Technology Policy

Ockerman Middle School is a 1:1 school where every student is provided a Chrome Book for academic use during the school day. As a result, students must keep all personal devices (cell phones, e-readers, etc.) turned off and in their locker during school hours (7:35AM – 2:30PM). Exceptions may be made by the administration for lunch periods as a reward.

Violations of Technology Policy – If a student violates the policy set by the teacher for classroom use of technology, the following consequences will be the result:

- **1st Offense:** Device is confiscated by teacher, and the student can pick it up from the office at the end of the day. Verbal warning.
- **2nd Offense:** Device is confiscated by teacher, and the student can pick it up from the office at the end of the day. Detention assigned.
- **3rd Offense:** Device is confiscated by teacher, and the parent will need to pick the device up in the office. Detention assigned.
- **4th Offense:** Device is confiscated by teacher, and the parent will need to pick the device up in the office. Friday School assigned.
- **5th Offense:** Device is confiscated by teacher, and the parent will need to pick the device up in the office. Friday School assigned. Device will have to be checked into the office each day upon arrival and picked up at the end of the day. This requirement will be in effect until the end of the semester.
- **6th Offense:** Principal's discretion.

Chromebook Usage Violations

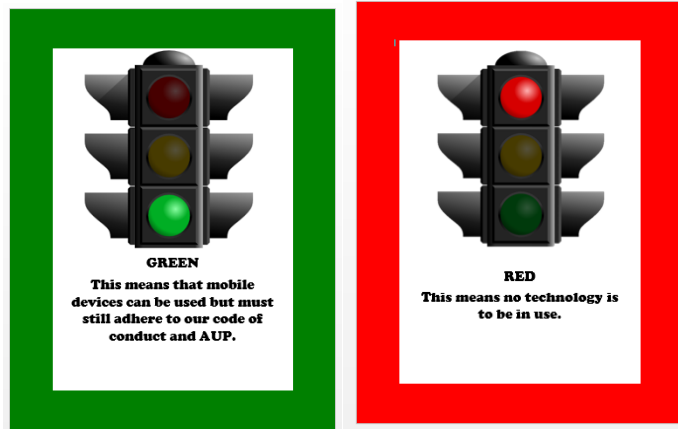
- **Off-Task:** This will be handled by the teacher like any other classroom management issue.
- **Damage (Intentional):** Student will be assigned Friday School or Suspended (case-by-case determination). An administrator will contact the parent. If the damage is outside of Boone County's warranty, parents could be responsible for the cost of the repair or for replacement. This will be stated in the contract that students will sign.
- **Damage (Accidental):** Accidental damage by students is expected and will be handled on a case-by-case basis, and informed by the circumstances surrounding the event.

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Chromebook Camera Violations

- **1st Offense:** Teacher will assist in removing any photos or videos from the device and issue a warning.
- **2nd Offense:** Teacher will assist in removing any photos or videos from the device and issue a detention.
- **3rd Offense:** Teacher will assist in removing any photos or videos from the device and issue a detention.
- **4th Offense:** Teacher will assist in removing any photos or videos from the device. An administrator will contact parents. Friday School assigned.
- **5th Offense:** Principal's discretion.
