

Determination of the Schedule of the School Day and Week

KRS160.345(2)(i)4

Scheduling (defined) – Scheduling shall mean the development of a master plan for using time within the school day set by the state and Board of Education and the use of time over a span of one week, and grading, period, one semester, and/or school year.

Responsibility – The principal shall develop annually a master plan for using school time within the school day as set by the state and local Board of Education.

Assistance – An Adhoc Committee shall provide assistance and/or input to the principal when developing a school schedule.

Criteria – The criteria to be met in scheduling shall include:

1. Promoting teacher effectiveness to the fullest.
2. Providing time for shared instructional planning and collaboration on a regular basis.
3. Providing access for all students to the four arts disciplines (dance, drama, music, and visual arts) as well as both practical living areas (health education, physical education) whenever possible.
4. Avoiding (whenever possible) scheduling single-section courses in the arts against single-section courses in required subjects.
5. Providing and protecting adequate time for students to be actively involved in creating, performing, and responding to the arts.
6. Complying with all federal, state, and Board regulations.
7. Supporting the school's instructional goals and program and service concepts.
