Dustin made motion to accept amended June agenda; Mary seconded.

Mr. Raleigh has accepted a position at the district office; Mr. Schlotman is acting Interim Principal.

Birkenhauer made motion to accept the May and July 25 minutes and Mrs. Dorn seconded.

First Reading of Dress Code Change Suggestions

Mrs. Kohl presented Dress Code suggestions from the Dress Code & Ad Hoc Committee.

- Remove from the dress code violations facial piercings, tattoos, capris pants, flip flops/shower shoes, and unnatural hair color.
- It is also suggested to allow leggings to be worn with a tunic top or dress that comes down mid-thigh or below and to allow holes in jeans—mid-thigh and below but not with excessive holes.
- This will bring BCHS more in line with other high schools in the district.

Presently in this year's Agenda—"Dress Code is under Review" has been noted.

Student Achievement—AP Data (handout)

BCHS and Boone County District scores per high school are examined.

While we have far fewer students taking AP classes, BCHS has more students taking Dual Enrollment than the other high schools in the district. However, our AP scores are competitive. See handout for breakdown per subject matter.

Budget Reports

School Activity Fund (Mrs. Ryan)

Athletic Report (Mr. Steele)

Mrs. Sutton: Has all the gate monies been split among the teams? Affirmative: Mr. Steele does that.

Soccer is now running its own concessions. Players are also selling season passes for their games.

Discussion of Concession: The idea of re-establishing an Athletic Boosters organization to fund raise for all sports, so that they are not all in competition with each other for funds was discussed. It could sell Rebel Spirit wear, running concessions, etc. BCHS did have one years ago.

Mrs. Sutton shared that in Lawrenceburg, Indiana, Boosters raise funds for each sport as well as academics and all extra-curricular school activities.

Following the Budget discussion, a motion to accept the reports was made by Mrs. Sutton and seconded by Mr. Herald.

Closed Session: Motion was made by Mrs. Birkenhauer and seconded by Mrs. Jones to go into a closed session.

Mrs. Birkenhauer made a motion to come out of Closed Session; it was seconded by Mrs. Jones.

Selection of a Vice Chair—was voted on and Allison Sutton was nominated.

Mr. Schlotman excused himself in order for Dr. Jim Detwiler, Assistant Superintendent to speak with Council about the principal selection process.

- First option: post position now; however, time factor and a small “pool” to choose from.
- Second option: go with an Interim and then post in January or February in order to get a wider pool of applicants. That would be the earliest to post for this position.

Superintendent will appoint the Interim and Assistant Principal (to take Mr. Schlotman’s position).

Discussion followed.

Motion was made to have an Interim Principal for a year; then, post for the position in January/February. Motion was made by Mrs. Dorn and seconded by Mr. Herald.

Motion to adjourn was made by Mrs. Jones and seconded by Mrs. Birkenhauer.

Meeting ended at 8:12 P.M.
