1) Gateways summer bridge program

- The goal is to assist students who have not reached bench mark in English and/or Math, but wish to get a jump start before entering college in the fall. The Summer Bridge pairs General Education math and English with a developmental support lab to allow students to remediate as well as providing free structured tutoring in those areas. Not only will students who complete the sequence of courses have the ability to start their freshman year with no developmental deficiencies, they can bring as many as 11 hours that will count toward graduation because of the manner that Gateway and KCTCS addresses remediation.
