



Education Enhancement Opportunity

Request for EHO's must be received by the office at least 10 days before the absence.

An EHO will NOT be approved after the absence event.

Your child has been tentatively approved for an Educational Enhancement Opportunity, known as an EHO. Missing school means that your child is receiving educational opportunities that cannot occur in the school. If approved, while you are away your child should complete a daily written journal for grades 1-5 or a picture journal for Kindergarten. The journal should contain information about the trip and the educational opportunities he or she has experienced. The report will be due 5 days after he/she returns to school. If your child fails to turn in their project the absence will be marked as parent note excused/unexcused (students are allowed 6 parent notes a year).

It is also important that your child stays caught up on their current school work. Please contact your child's teacher and request any assignments that your child will miss during their absence. This is also why advanced notice is needed; so there is time for your child's teacher to prepare any work needed while they are away.
