- A. **School Improvement Plan Approval** - James Brewer reviewed the recommended SIP with the council, including the documents (WIGs, walk-through data, and the Instructional Handbook), embedded within the plan. After discussion, a motion to approve the SIP was made by Holly Cobble and seconded by Allison Timaji. None opposed.
  
- B. **Data Dashboard** - James Brewer shared the comprehensive data dashboard with the council showing a breakdown state assessment from 2018 and 2019, fall STAR, and fall CASE data for our entire population and our sub populations for both reading and mathematics. The CASE and STAR serve as predictors for state assessment. One of the highlights of the data include the performance of our students with disabilities where

we achieved nearly 50% proficient/distinguished in both reading and math. See attached data by clicking [HERE](#). The second round of CASE assessments will be given to students on January 15th and 16th.

- C. **CASE Data Comparison** - James Brewer shared the CASE data comparison among all middle schools in Boone County. In the six possible categories (Reading - 6/7/8 and Math - 6/7/8), CMS was first in five of the six categories with one second place finish. See attached data by clicking [HERE](#).
