



Ockerman Elementary Site Based Article 8.0

Ockerman Elementary School Council Appeals Process

- A. **Request:** Any resident of the school's enrollment district, parents, student, or employee of the school may appeal decisions of the SBDM Council. For a person to appeal a decision of the council, the issue must be presented in writing by the appellant to the council for reconsideration. (Specifically, this written documentation must include (1) copy of the policy, code, or article for appeal and (2) specific explanation of the appeal.)
- B. **Schedule:** This written appeal shall be delivered to the principal (chair) who shall bring the matter before the SBDM Council at its next meeting, or schedule a special called meeting prior to the next regularly scheduled meeting. A meeting so scheduled shall comply with the requirements of the Open Meeting Law for special called meetings. The person(s) shall be informed of the meeting by letter.
- C. **Decision:** The SBDM Council shall consider the merits of the complaint, make a decision, and respond in writing to the appellant.
- D. **Report:** A copy of the appeal, and a written reply by the council, shall be provided to the Superintendent within ten (10) working days of the council's decision.
