

Ockerman Elementary Site Based Policy 6.10

Discipline Committee

a. Authorization and Purpose

The School Council shall establish a School Discipline Committee based on the PBIS model for the purpose of 1) establishing a common approach to discipline, 2) implementing positively stated expectations for all students and staff, 3) imposing a process for teaching these expectations to students, 4) implementing rewards and acknowledgement system, 5) developing a systematic approach to address misbehavior, and 6) monitoring and evaluating the effectiveness of the discipline system.

b. Committee

The Discipline Committee will include, but is not limited to

1. Facilitator
2. Coach
3. 2 Teachers (1 primary and 1 intermediate)
4. FRC Coordinator
5. Behavior Strategist
6. Counselor
7. School Psychologist

POLICY

Definition

PBIS (Positive Behavioral Intervention and Supports) is defined as a research based system ensuring a school culture and climate in the emphasis on a school-wide system of support that include proactive strategies for defining, teaching, and supporting appropriate student behaviors to create a positive school environment.

Discipline Committee Responsibilities

The committee shall promote success and sustainability of implementations of the PBIS process. The committee shall meet and examine data collected through the district mandated PBIS process and establish procedures to fit the needs of Ockerman Elementary through this process in accordance with Ockerman Elementary School based Council, Boone County Board of Education Policy, Kentucky State Statues, and Kentucky department of Education Regulations.

Council Involvement

The discipline committee shall submit PBIS information to the School Based Council throughout the development of the process.

Parent and Student Acknowledgement

A copy of student guidelines will be provided to parents through the student handbook. Parents/Guardians will read, sign, and return the guidelines to the school.

Regulation and Policy

Upon adoption by School Based Council, the student discipline process (PBIS) shall become part of policy.
