

Ockerman Elementary Site Based Policy 1.2

Ockerman Elementary School School Improvement Plan (SIP)

Authorization: KRS 160.345(j) Each school council shall annually review data as shown on state and local student assessments and program assessments required under KRS 158.6453. The data shall include but not be limited to information on performance levels of all students tested, and information on the performance of students disaggregated by race, gender, disability, English language learners, and participation in the federal free and reduced price lunch program. After completing the review of data, each school council, with the involvement of parents, faculty, and staff, shall develop and adopt a plan to ensure that each student makes progress toward meeting the goals set forth in KRS 158.645 and 158.6451(1)(b) by April 1 of each year and submit the plan to the superintendent and local board of education for review as described in KRS 160.340. The Kentucky Department of Education shall provide each school council the data needed to complete the review required by this paragraph no later than November 1 of each year. If a school does not have a council, the review shall be completed by the principal with the involvement of parents, faculty, and staff.

Definition: The SIP is a continuous plan for school improvement covering a time frame of two (2) years. The plan contains goals, strategies and activities, responsible individuals for goals, timelines, and cost estimations. It is a school wide plan that addresses priorities from 3 component areas: Academic Performance, Learning Environment, and Efficiency.

Responsibility: The Council will oversee the development of the SIP. It shall develop standing committees and ad hoc committees as needed to facilitate the planning process and review of goals.

Monitoring: The SIP shall be monitored by the Council and Principal. Revisions shall be made on an as needed basis or when a Goal or Activity has been successfully completed.
