

DRESS CODE FOR STUDENTS

1. Shirts (oxford, polo, turtleneck, and crew neck) with **no cleavage visible & no showing of midriff**. Shirts must have sleeves. Shirts may not be of transparent material.
3. Pants that are size appropriate and that **do not** touch the floor may be worn. Pants that are unacceptable include overalls, spandex, fleece, or nylon; shorts; skorts, or oversized pants. Pants must be worn at waist level. Writing on pants is prohibited. Excessive metal (loops, hooks, straps, etc) is prohibited. During special events when shorts are permitted to be worn, **shorts length must be close to the knee**.
4. Holes in jeans are acceptable, but must not be excessive in size or number. Jeans in tatters are not acceptable. **Students must wear something under the jeans so no skin is showing**.
5. Capri or crop pants, defined as $\frac{3}{4}$ length pants designed to hit mid-calf may be worn.
6. Leggings are acceptable provided the students are wearing a dress, skirt, shirt, or top that comes to mid-thigh or longer. **Spandex is still not acceptable**.
7. Appropriate sized belts, if worn, must be buckled and worn in belt loops.
8. Casual, sleeved dresses that pass the “flamingo” test, that do not have slits more than two inches above the knee, and that do not touch the floor. Dresses without collars must rest at the neckline.
9. Jackets/coats are not permitted to be worn in the classroom. These must be placed in the student’s locker.
